15	A real estate contract for the sale, conveyance or exchange of
16	real property, option to purchase real property, or a lease with an
17	option to purchase real property may include a contingency, not to
18	exceed one hundred eighty (180) days, for the purposes of securing
19	required permits, lot changes, zoning changes, and any other land
20	use approvals necessary to use and operate the real property.
21	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
