SENATE BILL 1180

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S. 2021, Section 63, which relates to general powers and authority of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services; providing for certain exemptions; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2021, Section 63, is amended to read as follows:

Section 63. A. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall have power to promulgate rules not inconsistent with the laws of this state.

B. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall have charge of the construction, repair, maintenance, insurance, and operation of all buildings owned, used, or occupied by or on behalf of the state including buildings owned by the Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority where such services are carried out by contract with the Authority, except as otherwise provided by law. Whenever feasible, the Office of Management and Enterprise Services may utilize the Construction Division of the Department of

1 Corrections for the construction and repair of buildings for the  
2 Department of Corrections.

3 C. The Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise  
4 Services shall have authority to purchase all material and perform  
5 all other duties necessary in the construction, repair, and  
6 maintenance of all buildings under its management or control, shall  
7 make all necessary contracts by or on behalf of the state for any  
8 buildings or rooms rented for the use of the state or any of the  
9 officers thereof, and shall have charge of the arrangement and  
10 allotment of space in such buildings among the different state  
11 officers except as otherwise provided by law.

12 D. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall not  
13 have any authority or responsibility for buildings, rooms or space  
14 under the management or control of the University Hospitals  
15 Authority.

16 E. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall not  
17 have any authority or responsibility for buildings, rooms, or space  
18 under the management or control of the Military Department of the  
19 State of Oklahoma.

20 F. The The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall have  
21 the custody and control of all state property, and all other  
22 property managed or used by the state, except military stores and  
23 such property under the control of the ~~State~~ Banking Department and  
24 the two houses of the ~~State~~ Legislature, shall procure all necessary

1 insurance thereon against loss and shall allot the use of the  
2 property to the several offices of the state, and prescribe where  
3 the property shall be kept for public use.

4 ~~F.~~ G. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall  
5 keep an accurate account of all property purchased for the state or  
6 any of the departments or officers thereof, except that purchased  
7 for and by the two houses of the ~~State~~ Legislature. The two houses  
8 shall have the exclusive use, care, and custody of their respective  
9 chambers, committee rooms, furniture, and property, and shall keep  
10 their respective records of said furniture and property.

11 ~~G.~~ H. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall  
12 not have any authority or responsibility for property purchased for  
13 or under the management or control of the University Hospitals  
14 Authority except as expressly provided by law.

15 ~~H.~~ I. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall  
16 not have any authority or responsibility for property purchased for  
17 or under the management or control of CompSource ~~Oklahoma~~ Mutual  
18 Insurance Company if CompSource ~~Oklahoma~~ Mutual Insurance Company is  
19 operating pursuant to a pilot program authorized by Sections 3316  
20 and 3317 of this title.

21 J. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall not  
22 have any authority or responsibility for property purchased for or  
23 under the management control of the Military Department of the State  
24 of Oklahoma except as expressly provided by law.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
