SENATE BILL 1198

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to child care; defining term;
prohibiting certain acts by child care facility;
specifying applicability of section; providing
penalties; providing for codification; and declaring
an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 414.1 of Title 10, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. As used in this section, "vaccine passport" means
documentation that an individual has been vaccinated against
Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19).

B. A child care facility shall not:

1. Require a vaccination against COVID-19 as a condition of
enrollment in or attendance of the child care facility;

2. Require a vaccine passport as a condition of enrollment in
or attendance of the child care facility; or

3. Implement a mask mandate for children.

1 C. This section shall apply to all child care facilities
2 licensed by the Department of Human Services.

3 D. Violation of this section shall be grounds for revocation or
4 denial of issuance of the child care facility license as provided by
5 Section 407 of Title 10 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

6 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
