16	A. As used in this section, "vaccine passport" means
17	documentation that an individual has been vaccinated against
18	Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19).
19	B. A child care facility shall not:
20	1. Require a vaccination against COVID-19 as a condition of
21	enrollment in or attendance of the child care facility;
22	2. Require a vaccine passport as a condition of enrollment in
23	or attendance of the child care facility; or

3. Implement a mask mandate for children.

C. This section shall apply to all child care facilities licensed by the Department of Human Services. D. Violation of this section shall be grounds for revocation or denial of issuance of the child care facility license as provided by Section 407 of Title 10 of the Oklahoma Statutes. SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval. 58-2-3292 DC 1/6/2022 10:53:35 AM
