A. The State Board of Education shall 17 promulgate rules providing for limited exemptions from the mandated 18 tests administered pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma School 19 Testing Program Act for students facing exceptional emergency 20 circumstances which prevent the student from being assessed during 21 the testing window. For purposes of this section, exceptional 22 emergency circumstance shall be defined to include situations 23 involving serious accidents or medical emergency events involving 24

1 the student, a parent or quardian of the student or a sibling of the 2 student. 3 B. The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules 4 providing for limited exceptions for tests mandated by the Oklahoma 5 School Testing Program Act to be administered outside of the testing 6 window. The limited exceptions shall provide for mandated tests to 7 be administered outside of the testing window to: 8 1. A student whose school site within the same school district 9 changes or whose resident school district changes due to placement 10 by an agency having legal custody of the child pursuant to a court 11 order or by a state agency having legal custody of the child 12 pursuant to the provisions of Title 10A of the Oklahoma Statutes; 13 and 14 2. A student who has been classified as homeless according to 15 the federal definition set forth in 42 U.S.C., Section 11434a. 16 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022. 17 SECTION 3.
