SENATE BILL 1221

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the practice of pharmacy;  
authorizing pharmacist to enter into certain  
collaborative practice agreements; defining term;  
directing promulgation of rules; providing for  
codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 353.31 of Title 59, unless there  
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. A pharmacist may enter into a collaborative practice  
agreement with one or more practitioners licensed in this state.

B. As used in this section, "collaborative practice agreement"  
means a formal agreement in which a licensed practitioner makes a  
diagnosis, supervises patient care, and refers patients to a  
pharmacist under a protocol that allows the pharmacist to perform  
specific patient care functions.

C. The State Board of Pharmacy shall promulgate rules to  
implement the provisions of this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
