SENATE BILL 1230

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to memorial highways and bridges;  
creating the "SP-4 Wilbert Gresham Memorial Highway";  
requiring certain markers; providing for  
codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.364 of Title 69, unless  
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The section of U.S. Highway 266 beginning at the intersection of  
Porter Road, extending north easterly to the intersection of County  
Road N4030 in Okmulgee County, shall be designated the "SP-4 Wilbert  
Gresham Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall  
cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on  
the highway.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
