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6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to property and casualty insurance;
8 providing definitions; requiring written permission
9 for making certain claim by roofing contractor;
10 requiring written permission for insurer to accept
11 certain claim; providing for codification; and
12 providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1160 of Title 59, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. For the purposes of this section:

18 1. "Casualty insurance" means insurance as defined pursuant to
19 Section 707 of Title 36 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

20 2. "Property insurance" means insurance as defined pursuant to
21 Section 704 of Title 36 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and

22 3. "Roofing contractor" means a roofing contractor as defined
23 pursuant to paragraph 18 of Section 1151.2 of Title 59 of the
24 Oklahoma Statutes.

1 B. Any roofing contractor providing services including but not
2 limited to repair or improvement services to be paid from the
3 proceeds of a property or casualty insurance policy shall not file
4 an insurance claim on behalf of the insured without express written
5 permission from the insured. Property and casualty insurance
6 providers shall not accept claims from any other entity or person
7 other than the insured for services under this subsection without
8 express written permission from the insured permitting the
9 submission of the claim.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.

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
