16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:							
17	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 1135.2, as							
18	last amended by Section 4, Chapter 276, O.S.L. 2021, is amended to							
19	read as follows:							
20	Section 1135.2. A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby							
21	authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license							
22	plates to persons in recognition of their service or awards as							
23	provided by this section.

Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been registered for the current year.

6 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax 7 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall 8 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates. 9 The Tax Commission shall send the notifications to the electronic 10 mail address provided by the person. If a person does not provide 11 an electronic mail address, the Tax Commission shall notify the 12 person by mail. The notice shall contain all necessary information 13 and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure upon 14 presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax Commission. The 15 license plates shall be issued on a staggered system except for 16 legislative plates and amateur radio operator license plates.

17 On and after January 1, 2022, if a special license plate is 18 issued pursuant to this section, any registration fee required for 19 such plate pursuant to this section and the fee required pursuant to 20 Section 1132 of this title shall be remitted at the same time and 21 subject to a single registration period. The Oklahoma Tax 22 Commission shall determine, by rule, a method for making required 23 fee and registration period adjustments if a special license plate 24 is obtained during a twelve-month period for which a registration \_ \_

<sup>1</sup> fee has already been remitted pursuant to Section 1132 of this <sup>2</sup> title. The combination of fees in a single remittance shall not <sup>3</sup> alter the apportionment otherwise provided for in this section.

4 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a 5 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept 6 applications for special license plates authorized under this 7 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's 8 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount 9 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary 10 information directly into such system and generate a receipt 11 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents 12 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for 13 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for 14 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the 15 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

B. The special license plates provided by this section are as follows:

18 1. Prisoner of War License Plates - such plates shall be 19 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United 20 States Armed Forces and civilians who were former prisoners of war 21 held by a foreign country and who can provide proper certification 22 of that status. Such persons may apply for a prisoner of war 23 license plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having 24 a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving

1 spouse of any deceased former prisoner of war, if the spouse has not 2 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by 3 death, divorce or annulment, may apply for a prisoner of war license 4 plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton 5 The fee provided by this section for the special license or less. 6 plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other 7 registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees 8 levied by Section 1132 of this title;

9 2. National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
10 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma National
11 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
12 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
13 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

Air National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma Air National Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

19 4. United States Armed Forces - such plates shall be designed 20 for active, retired, former or reserve members of the United States 21 Armed Forces, and shall identify which branch of service, and carry 22 the emblem and name of either the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or 23 Coast Guard, according to the branch of service to which the member 24 belongs or did belong. Former members who have been dishonorably

Persons applying <sup>2</sup> for such license plate must show proof of present or past military <sup>3</sup> service by presenting a valid Uniformed Services Identity Card or <sup>4</sup> the United States Department of Defense Form (DD)214 form DD 214. <sup>5</sup> Retired or former members who are eligible for such plates shall <sup>6</sup> provide proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not <sup>7</sup> be required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

5. Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient License Plates - such
plates shall be designed for any resident of this state who has been

14 6. Missing In Action License Plates - such plates shall be 15 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who are 16 missing in action. The spouse of such missing person, if the spouse 17 has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is 18 terminated by death, divorce or annulment, and each parent of the 19 missing person may apply for a missing in action license plate upon 20 presenting proper certification that the person is missing in action 21 and that the person making the application is the qualifying spouse 22 or the parent of the missing person. The qualifying spouse and each 23 parent of the missing person may each apply for the missing in

1 action license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
2 of one (1) ton or less;

3 7. Purple Heart Recipient License Plates - such plates shall be 4 designed for any resident of this state presenting proper 5 certification from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs 6 or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that such 7 resident has been awarded the Purple Heart military decoration. 8 Such persons may apply for a Purple Heart recipient license plate 9 for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or 10 The surviving spouse of any deceased veteran who has been less. 11 awarded the Purple Heart military decoration, if such spouse has not 12 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage has been terminated 13 by death, divorce or annulment, may apply for such plate for one 14 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The 15 license plate created by this paragraph shall be exempt from the fee 16 provided by this section for special license plates;

17 8. Pearl Harbor Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
18 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
19 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
20 the United States as being:

a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on December
7, 1941,

b. stationed on December 7, 1941, during the hours of
7:55 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. Hawaii time at Pearl Harbor,

Killed in Action License Plates - such plates shall be designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were killed in action. The spouse of the deceased person, if the spouse

1 has not remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by 2 death, divorce or annulment, may apply for a killed in action 3 license plate upon presenting proper certification that the person 4 was killed in action and that the person making the application is 5 the qualifying spouse of the deceased person. The qualifying spouse 6 may apply for a killed in action license plate for no more than two 7 vehicles with each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) 8 ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special 9 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to 10 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration 11 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

12 12. Gold Star Parents License Plates - such plates shall be 13 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were 14 killed during a war. The parents of the deceased person may apply 15 for a gold star license plate upon presenting proper certification 16 that the person was killed during a war and that the person making 17 the application is the parent of the deceased person. The parent 18 may apply for a gold star parent license plate for no more than two 19 vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one 20 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special 21 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to 22 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration 23 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

1 13. Military Decoration License Plates - such plates shall be designed for any resident of this state who has been awarded the Distinguished Service Medal, the Distinguished Service Cross, the Distinguished Flying Cross, the Bronze Star military decoration or the Silver Star military decoration. Such persons may apply for a military decoration license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

8 14. Vietnam Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be 9 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United 10 States Armed Forces who served in the Vietnam Conflict. Such 11 persons may apply for a Vietnam veteran license plate for each 12 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less; 13 15. Police Officer License Plates - such plates shall be 14 designed for any currently employed, reserve or retired municipal 15 police officer or full-time, reserve or retired university police 16 officer certified by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and 17 Training or common education police officer certified by the Council 18 on Law Enforcement Education and Training. Police officers may 19 apply for police officer license plates for vehicles with a rated 20 capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon proof of 21 employment by or retirement from a municipal, university or common 22 education police department by either an identification card or 23 letter from the chief of the police department or the Oklahoma 24 Police Pension and Retirement Board. <sup>1</sup> such plates shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial <sup>2</sup> application, but shall not be required to provide proof of <sup>3</sup> eligibility annually. The license plates shall be designed in <sup>4</sup> consultation with municipal police departments of this state; <sup>5</sup> provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design <sup>6</sup> to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in <sup>7</sup> order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate;

8 16. World War II Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be 9 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United 10 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be 11 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of 12 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having 13 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from 14 September 16, 1940, to December 7, 1945. The former members may 15 apply for a World War II Veteran license plate for vehicles with a 16 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

17 The license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" and shall 18 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia 19 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold 20 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, U.S. Army Air Corps, 21 Marines or Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which 22 the member belonged. For the purpose of license plate 23 identification, the plate shall contain four digits, two digits at 24 the left and two digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. \_ \_

Centered on the bottom of the license plate shall be the words WORLD WAR II";

3 17. Korean War Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be 4 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United 5 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be 6 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of 7 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having 8 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from June 9 27, 1950, to January 31, 1955, both dates inclusive. The former 10 members may apply for a Korean War Veteran license plate for 11 vehicles with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

12 The license plate shall have the legend "OKLAHOMA" and shall 13 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia 14 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold 15 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or 16 Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which the member 17 belonged. For the purpose of license plate identification, the 18 plate shall contain four digits, two digits at the left and two 19 digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. Centered on the 20 bottom of the license plate shall be the word "KOREA";

21 18. Municipal Official License Plates - such plates shall be 22 designed for persons elected to a municipal office in this state and 23 shall designate the name of the municipality and the district or

1 ward in which the municipal official serves. The plates shall only
2 be produced upon application;

3 19. Red Cross Volunteer License Plates - such plates shall be 4 designed to honor American Red Cross volunteers and staff who are 5 residents of this state. Such persons must present an 6 identification card issued by the American Red Cross and bearing a 7 photograph of the person. The license plate shall be designed with 8 the assistance of the American Red Cross and shall have the legend 9 "Oklahoma OK!" in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the legend the 10 symbol of the American Red Cross and no more than three letters and 11 three numbers shall be in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the 12 symbol and letters and numbers shall be the words "American Red 13 Cross" in black. The plates shall not be subject to the design 14 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other 15 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each 16 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue;

17 20. Desert Storm License Plates - such plates shall be designed 18 and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of the 19 United States Armed Forces who served in the Persian Gulf Crisis and 20 the Desert Storm operation. Such persons may apply for a Desert 21 Storm license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity 22 of one (1) ton or less;

23 21. Military Reserve Unit License Plates - such plates shall be 24 designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of

<sup>1</sup> a reserve unit of the United States Armed Forces. Such persons may <sup>2</sup> apply for a Military Reserve Unit license plate for each vehicle <sup>3</sup> with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

22. Oklahoma City Bombing Victims and Survivors License Plates
- such plates shall be designed and issued to any victim or survivor
of the bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building in
downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995;

8 23. Civil Air Patrol License Plates - such plates shall be
9 designed and issued to any person who is a member of the Civil Air
10 Patrol. Such persons may apply for a Civil Air Patrol license plate
11 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
12 less upon proof of membership in the Civil Air Patrol. The license
13 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Civil Air Patrol;

14 24. Ninety-Nines License Plates - such plates shall be designed 15 and issued to members of the Ninety-Nines. Persons applying for 16 such license plate must show proof of membership in the Ninety-17 Nines. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with 18 the Ninety-Nines;

25. Combat Infantryman Badge License Plates - such plates shall
be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Infantryman Badge.
The plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK". Below the legend
shall be the Combat Infantryman Badge and three numbers. Below the
badge and the numbers shall be the words "Combat Infantryman Badge".
Such persons may apply for a Combat Infantryman Badge license plate

1 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or 2 less;

Somalia Combat Veterans License Plates - such plates shall <sup>4</sup> be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member <sup>5</sup> of the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in the United <sup>6</sup> Nations relief effort. Such persons may apply for a Somalia Combat <sup>7</sup> Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying <sup>8</sup> capacity of one (1) ton or less;

9 27. Police Chaplain License Plates - such plates shall be
10 designed and issued to members of the International Conference of
11 Police Chaplains (ICPC) who have completed the ICPC requirements for
12 basic certification as a police chaplain. The license plates shall
13 be designed in consultation with the ICPC;

14 28. Joint Service Commendation Medal License Plates - such 15 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state 16 who has been awarded the Joint Service Commendation Medal by the 17 United States Secretary of Defense;

18 29. Merchant Marine License Plates - such plates shall be 19 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission 20 by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs, and issued to any 21 person who during combat was a member of the Merchant Marines as 22 certified by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs. Such 23 license plate may be issued for each vehicle with a rated carrying 24 capacity of one (1) ton or less; \_ \_

<sup>1</sup> 30. Legislative License Plates - such plates shall be designed <sup>2</sup> for persons elected to the Oklahoma Legislature and shall designate <sup>3</sup> the house of the Legislature in which the legislator serves and the <sup>4</sup> district number;

5 31. Disabled Veterans License Plates - such plates shall be 6 designed for persons presenting proper certification from the United 7 States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the 8 United States certifying such veteran has a service-connected 9 disability rating of fifty percent (50%) or more, regardless which 10 agency pays the disability benefits, or that such veteran has been 11 awarded a vehicle by the United States government or receives a 12 grant from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs for the 13 purchase of an automobile due to a service-connected disability 14 rating or due to the loss of use of a limb or an eye. Such persons 15 may apply to the Tax Commission for a disabled veterans license 16 plate or to a motor license agent for a regular license plate for no 17 more than two vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying 18 capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving spouse of any 19 deceased disabled veteran, if the spouse has not since remarried, or 20 if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by death, divorce or 21 annulment, or a surviving spouse in receipt of Dependency and 22 Indemnity Compensation from the United States Department of Veterans 23 Affairs, may apply for a disabled veterans license plate for one 24 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. <sup>1</sup> fee provided by this section for the special license plate <sup>2</sup> authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other <sup>3</sup> registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees <sup>4</sup> levied by Section 1132 of this title. The total expense of this <sup>5</sup> license plate shall not exceed Five Dollars (\$5.00).

6 If the person qualifies for a disabled veterans license plate 7 and is also eligible for a physically disabled placard under the 8 provisions of Section 15-112 of this title, the person shall be 9 eligible to receive a disabled veterans license plate that also 10 displays the international accessibility symbol, which is a stylized 11 human figure in a wheelchair. Upon the death of the disabled 12 veteran with a disabled veterans license plate with the 13 international accessibility symbol, the plate shall be returned to 14 the Tax Commission;

33. Oklahoma Military Academy Alumni License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is an alumnus of the Oklahoma Military Academy. Such persons may apply for an Oklahoma Military Academy Alumnus license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

<sup>1</sup> The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the <sup>2</sup> Oklahoma Military Academy and shall contain the shield of the <sup>3</sup> Academy;

4 34. Amateur Radio Operator License Plates - such plates shall 5 be designed and issued to any person, holding a valid operator's 6 license, technician class or better, issued by the Federal 7 Communications Commission, and who is also the owner of a motor 8 vehicle currently registered in Oklahoma, in which has been 9 installed amateur mobile transmitting and receiving equipment. 10 Eligible persons shall be entitled to two special vehicle 11 identification plates as herein provided. Application for such 12 identification plates shall be on a form prescribed by the Tax 13 Commission and the plates issued to such applicant shall have 14 stamped thereon the word "Oklahoma" and bear the official call 15 letters of the radio station assigned by the Federal Communications 16 Commission to the individual amateur operator thereof. All 17 applications for such plates must be made to the Tax Commission on 18 or before the first day of October of any year for such plates for 19 the following calendar year and must be accompanied by the fee 20 required in this section together with a certificate, or such other 21 evidence as the Tax Commission may require, of proof that applicant 22 has a valid technician class or better amateur operator's license 23 and proof of applicant's ownership of a vehicle in which radio 24 receiving and transmitting equipment is installed. The right to such special identification plates herein provided for shall continue until the amateur radio operator's license of the person to whom such plates are issued expires or is revoked;

6 35. American Legion License Plates - such plates shall be
7 designed for members of the American Legion. Persons applying for
8 such license plate must show proof of membership. The license
9 plates shall be designed in consultation with the American Legion of
10 Oklahoma;

11 36. Deputy Sheriff License Plates - such plates shall be 12 designed for any currently employed or retired county sheriff or 13 deputy sheriff. County sheriffs or deputy sheriffs may apply for 14 such plates for vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or 15 less upon proof of employment by or retirement from a county 16 sheriff's office by either an identification card or letter from the 17 county sheriff or a government-sponsored retirement board from which 18 the county sheriff or deputy sheriff may be receiving a pension. 19 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of 20 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to 21 provide proof of eligibility annually. The license plates shall be 22 designed in consultation with the county sheriff offices of this 23 state;

  United States Armed Forces or as a member of the
  Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a direct result
  of the performance of duties for any branch of the
  United States Armed Forces or Oklahoma National Guard
  while on active military duty, or

Section 1135.4. A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby authorized to design and issue personalized license plates. The personalized license plates shall be issued on a staggered system except for vintage decals.

Personalized special license plates shall not be transferred to any other person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of ownership and retained. The personalized special license plate may then be used on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been registered for the current year.

15 Personalized special license plates shall be renewed each year 16 by the Tax Commission or a motor license agent, unless authorized by 17 the Tax Commission to be renewed for a period greater than one (1) 18 year. The Tax Commission shall notify by mail all persons issued 19 special license plates.
