plan administered in this state as described pursuant to Section 6060.11 of Title 36 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

- B. The Insurance Department is hereby directed to conduct a market conduct examination to analyze the non-quantitative limitations of mental health parity. The study shall include an assessment of network adequacy for the purposes of reporting the availability of in-network mental health providers. The Department shall use annual reports provided to the Department pursuant to subsection E of Section 6060.11 of Title 36 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
- C. The Department shall furnish the examination findings to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the Governor, and publish the examination findings on the Mental Health Parity page of the Department website no later than July 1, 2023.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
