6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to motorized scooters; amending 47
8 O.S. 2021, Section 1-133.3, which relates to the
9 definition of a motorized scooter; modifying
10 definition; requiring minimum age to operate a
11 motorized scooter; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 1-133.3, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 1-133.3. Motorized scooter.

16 A. A "motorized scooter" is any vehicle having:

- 17 1. Not more than three wheels in contact with the ground;
18 2. Handlebars and a foot support or seat for the use of the

operator;

19 3. A power source that is capable of propelling the vehicle at
20 a maximum design speed of not more than ~~twenty-five (25)~~ thirty-five
21 (35) miles per hour on level ground, and:

- 22 a. if the power source is a combustion engine, has a
23 piston or rotor displacement of ~~thirty-five~~ fifty
24 cubic centimeters ~~(35 cu cm)~~ (50 cu cm) or less

1 regardless of the number of chambers in the power
2 source,

3 b. if the power source is electric, has a power output of
4 not more than one thousand (1,000) watts.

5 B. For purposes of this section, an electric personal assistive
6 mobility device, as defined in Section 1-114A of this title,
7 bicycle, electric-assisted bicycle, or motorized bicycle, as defined
8 in Section 1-104 of this title, shall not be considered a motorized
9 scooter.

10 C. A motorized scooter shall not be required to be registered
11 under the laws of this state. The operator of a motorized scooter
12 shall be at least fourteen (14) years of age and shall not be
13 required to possess a driver license or to comply with the vehicle
14 insurance or financial responsibility laws of this state.

15 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
