5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to public health; requiring certain
7 persons to provide education on infant
8 cardiopulmonary resuscitation and basic first aid to
9 individuals who are pregnant or planning to become
pregnant; providing for codification; and providing
an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-233.1 of Title 63, unless
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 All persons licensed to practice medicine and surgery in this
16 state, or who are Advanced Registered Practice Nurses including but
17 not limited to Certified Nurse-Midwives, and who provide prenatal,
18 delivery, infant care services, and other child or adult health
19 services related to maternal and infant care shall provide education
20 related to infant cardiopulmonary resuscitation and basic first aid
21 to individuals who report to such person that they are pregnant or
22 planning to become pregnant.

23 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
