SENATE BILL 1575

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to memorial highway and bridge designations; establishing the William Mark Miller Memorial Highway; requiring certain markers; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.670 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The section of Interstate 44 beginning one half mile north of State Highway 36 interchange extending south to U.S. Highway 70 interchange, in Cotton County, shall be designated the "William Mark Miller Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
