6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the State Department of Education;
8 directing the Department to develop and operate
9 certain website for school district employment
10 vacancies; requiring submitted employment vacancies
11 to include certain information; providing for
12 promulgation of rules; providing for codification;
13 providing an effective date; and declaring an
14 emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-104.12 of Title 70, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. The State Department of Education shall develop and operate
20 a website listing school district employment vacancies through
21 which:

- 22 1. A school district may submit employment vacancies; and
- 23 2. School district employment candidates may submit
24 applications and resumes for school district vacancies in a
25 standardized format.

1 B. The employment vacancies submitted pursuant to paragraph 1
2 of subsection A of this section shall include:

- 3 1. The job title, major work duties, and minimum
4 qualifications;
- 5 2. The pay range;
- 6 3. The desired start date for a successful candidate; and
- 7 4. The time limits and procedure for filing an application
8 through the website.

9 C. The State Board of Education may promulgate rules to
10 implement the provisions of this section.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022.

12 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
13 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
14 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
15 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
