SENATE BILL 1634

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; directing a school district's State Aid allocation to be withheld under certain circumstances; providing for reinstatement of State Aid allocation under certain circumstance; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 18-203 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Beginning with the 2022-2023 school year any school district in this state, as defined by Section 1-108 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, which knowingly and willfully violates state law, as determined by a court of competent jurisdiction, shall have their district's State Aid allocation withheld beginning in the month after the violation and shall be withheld until the school district is found to no longer be in violation of the law.

B. The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this section.

1       SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022.

2       SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
3 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
4 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
5 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
