A. All municipal elections shall be held at 16 the same place and in the same manner prescribed for conduct of 17 state and county elections unless otherwise provided by law. 18 B. A All elections of a municipality may adopt an ordinance 19 requiring its elections to shall be partisan. If such an ordinance 20 is adopted, a municipality shall notify the county election board 21 that its election is to be partisan in its resolution calling for an 22 election. If a municipality fails to notify the county election 23 board that its election will be on a partisan basis in the

resolution calling for an election, then the municipal election

shall be on a nonpartisan basis. Provided, any municipality which is governed by a charter may provide otherwise by charter or ordinance.

- C. All precincts totally or partially contained within the limits of a municipality shall be open for all elections held by such municipality; provided, however, that a municipality may authorize any precinct which is only partially contained within the limits of the municipality not to be opened by certifying to the county election board in its resolution calling for an election that no persons reside within that portion of the precinct contained within the limits of the municipality. Polling places shall be open from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. Precinct officials shall be the same as for state and county elections; provided, however, that substitutions, if necessary, shall be made by the secretary of the county election board.
- D. Except as otherwise provided by law, the laws governing state and county Primary and General Elections shall be applicable to all municipal elections.
- E. All municipal elections, including elections for municipalities with home rule charters, shall be held only on dates identified in Section 3-101 of this title.
- SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2021, Section 13A-101, is amended to read as follows:

Section 13A-101. A. Except as otherwise provided by law, the general election laws shall apply to all elections for school districts and technology center school districts. All elections for school districts and technology center school districts shall be partisan. When it is impossible or impractical to apply the general election laws for school districts and technology center school districts, the Secretary of the State Election Board shall prescribe procedures consistent with the purposes of the general election laws.

- B. All precincts totally or partially contained within the boundaries of a school district or a technology center school district shall be open for all elections held by such school district or technology center school district except as otherwise provided in this section. A school district or technology center school district may authorize any precinct which is only partially located within the boundaries of the district not to be opened by certifying to the county election board in the resolution calling for an election that no persons reside within that portion of the precinct contained within the boundaries of the district.
- C. The Secretary of the State Election Board is authorized to promulgate rules setting forth procedures to allow the board of education of a school district or career technology school district to request that a precinct only partially located within the district's boundaries, and in which there are one hundred (100)
