Have not less than five (5) years experience in government, 7 law or finance; and 8 3. Meet other specific requirements as specified by the 9 Commissioners of the Land Office. 10 11 12

C. The Secretary of the Land Office shall serve a four-year term of service concurrent with the term of the appointing Governor and the other elected officials on the Commission. The Secretary may serve consecutive terms and may serve past the term of the appointing Governor only until a successor is appointed. appointment is terminated or if the Secretary resigns, becomes incapacitated or for any reason is unable to perform the duties of the Secretary, the Commissioners may appoint an acting Secretary until a replacement may be appointed to complete the term as provided for in this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
