20	B. It is a discriminatory practice for a licensed dealer as
21	defined in subsection A of Section 1289.28 of Title 21 of the
22	Oklahoma Statutes to deny an individual the full and equal enjoyment
23	of the goods, services, facilities, privileges, advantages, and
