SENATE BILL 1712

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to vaccination status; amending 25 O.S. 2021, Section 1402, which relates to discriminatory practice; making it discriminatory practice for licensed dealers to deny service due to vaccination status; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 25 O.S. 2021, Section 1402, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1402. A. It is a discriminatory practice for a person to deny an individual the full and equal enjoyment of the goods, services, facilities, privileges, advantages, and accommodations of a "place of public accommodation" because of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, age, or disability.

B. It is a discriminatory practice for a licensed dealer as defined in subsection A of Section 1289.28 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes to deny an individual the full and equal enjoyment of the goods, services, facilities, privileges, advantages, and

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
