17	marriage in this state; provided, however, any common law marriage
18	recognized as valid by a court of competent jurisdiction in this
19	state or any other state prior to November 1, 2022, shall continue
20	to be recognized as valid in this state.
21	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
