16	By the effective date of this act, the State Election Board
17	shall update the system used for ballots for elections in Oklahoma
18	to meet the following requirements:
19	1. All ballots shall have a unique identifier number or code
20	printed in at least two locations on the ballot;
21	2. All ballots shall have a perforated section that includes
22	the unique identifier number or code where the voter can tear off
23	that portion of the ballot to keep as a method to identify his or

Ballots shall be digitized and made available to the general 2 public within thirty (30) days of each election to include the 3 following requirements: 4 all ballots shall be digitized and uploaded to a 5 publicly accessible website where the public can 6 scroll through and view all ballots, 7 b. all digitized ballots shall be searchable by the 8 ballot unique identifier number or code, 9 C. all digitized ballots shall be maintained and 10 searchable on the publicly accessible website for at 11 least two (2) years after the election, 12 d. all digitized ballot search options may be limited to 13 the county or precinct level in order to maintain 14 smaller file sizes on the publicly accessible website; 15 The Secretary of the State Election Board shall promulgate 16 rules for the implementation of this section. 17 SECTION 2.
