13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4004 of Title 59, unless there
16	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	A. By July 1, 2022, every administrative body, state agency
18	director or official with authority over any occupational or
19	professional license or certification shall develop and promulgate
20	administrative rules to ensure no individual who has obtained an
21	occupational or professional licensure or certification from this
22	state may have such license or certification revoked or suspended
23	solely for failure to make their scheduled student loan payments or
24 27	being delinquent on their student loans.

1	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2021.
2	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
3	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
4	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
5	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
