6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to school employees; directing that a
8 member of the Legislature who serves as certain
9 employee shall not participate in or receive certain
benefits; providing for codification; and providing
conditional effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 26-109 of Title 70, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 In the event that a member of the Legislature serves as an
17 employee of a school district, a technology center school district
18 or an institution within The Oklahoma State System of Higher
19 Education pursuant to the provisions of subsection B of Section 23
20 of Article V of the Oklahoma Constitution, the member shall not:

21 1. Be entitled to participate in the Teachers' Retirement
22 System in connection with such employment;

1 2. Receive any benefits pursuant to the Oklahoma Employees
2 Insurance and Benefits Act other than those allowed in connection
3 with service as a member of the Legislature; or

4 3. Receive any other benefits other than the compensation
5 directly attributable to his or her employment as provided for in
6 this section, which shall not exceed the compensation paid to
7 persons who are not members of the Legislature who are providing
8 equivalent or substantially similar services.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective upon certification
10 of election returns favoring passage of the Constitutional Amendment
11 proposed in Senate Joint Resolution No. 1 of the 1st Session of the
12 58th Oklahoma Legislature.
