7 An Act relating to appropriations; making an
8 appropriation to the Department of Transportation;
9 stating purpose; providing lapse dates; requiring and
prohibiting certain budget procedures; and declaring
an emergency.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of
14 Transportation from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
15 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
16 ending June 30, 2023, the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars
17 (\$100,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the
18 duties imposed upon the Department of Transportation by law.

19 SECTION 2. Appropriations made by Section 1 of this act, not
20 including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be
21 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023 (hereafter FY-23)
22 or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024
23 (hereafter FY-24). Funds budgeted for FY-23 may be encumbered only
24 through June 30, 2023 and must be expended by November 15, 2023.

1 Any funds remaining after November 15, 2023, and not budgeted for
2 FY-24, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then
3 current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-24 may be encumbered
4 only through June 30, 2024. Any funds remaining after November 15,
5 2024, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then
6 current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be budgeted in
7 both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-23, and not
8 required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted
9 for FY-24, after the agency to which the funds have been
10 appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program
11 revision removing these funds from the FY-23 budget work program and
12 after such revision has been approved by the Office of Management
13 and Enterprise Services.

14 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
15 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
16 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
17 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
