15	specified date; requiring related rulemaking by Oklahoma Tax Commission; requiring single remittance
16	of specified fees and single registration period for specified special or personalized license plates
17	after specified date; requiring the surrender of standard issue license plate under certain
18	circumstance; requiring proper display of special or personalized plate; requiring related rulemaking by
19	Oklahoma Tax Commission; construing provision with respect to apportionment; deleting obsolete language;
20	providing for motor license agent fee when single fee is remitted for registration and special or
21	personalized license plate; modifying reference; updating statutory references; and providing an
22	effective date.

24 27 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1116, is amended to read as follows:

4 Section 1116. A. Twelve registration periods shall be 5 established for vehicles required to be registered on a staggered 6 basis. The registration periods shall start on the first day of 7 each calendar month and shall end on the last day of that month. 8 Unless otherwise provided, all such vehicles where the date of 9 execution of transfer of ownership occurs in this state at any time 10 during a calendar month shall be subject to registration and payment 11 of the fee for the registration period commencing the first day of 12 the month of such date of execution of transfer.

13 B. A person who registers more than one vehicle may have all of 14 such vehicles initially registered at the same time or at separate 15 times. Any person who obtains a vehicle may, upon registration, 16 have the registration period adjusted to allow future registration 17 of all such vehicles at the same period or at a different period. 18 C. On and after January 1, 2022, if a special or personalized 19 license plate is issued pursuant to this title for a vehicle which 20 is subject to the requirements of Section 1132 of this title, the 21 registration periods for the vehicle may be combined into a single 22 registration period. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall determine, 23 by rule, a method for adjusting the twelve-month period.

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1132, as amended by Section 2, Chapter 337, O.S.L. 2012 (47 O.S. Supp. 2020, Section 1132), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1132. A. For all vehicles, unless otherwise
specifically provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
Registration Act, a registration fee shall be assessed at the time
of initial registration by the owner and annually thereafter, for
the use of the avenues of public access within this state in the
following amounts:

10 1. For the first through the fourth year of registration in 11 this state or any other state, Eighty-five Dollars (\$85.00);

12 2. For the fifth through the eighth year of registration in 13 this state or any other state, Seventy-five Dollars (\$75.00);

14 3. For the ninth through the twelfth year of registration in 15 this state or any other state, Fifty-five Dollars (\$55.00);

¹⁶ 4. For the thirteenth through the sixteenth year of ¹⁷ registration in this state or any other state, Thirty-five Dollars ¹⁸ (\$35.00); and

19 5. For the seventeenth and any following year of registration
 20 in this state or any other state, Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00).

The registration fee provided for in this subsection shall be in lieu of all other taxes, general or local, unless otherwise specifically provided.

1	On and after January 1, 2022, if a special or personalized
2	license plate is issued pursuant to Sections 1135.1 through 1135.7
3	of this title, any registration fee required for such plate and the
4	fee required pursuant to this subsection shall be remitted at the
5	same time and subject to a single registration period. Upon receipt
6	of a special or personalized plate, the standard issue license plate
7	must be surrendered to the Oklahoma Tax Commission or motor license
8	agent. The special or personalized plate must be properly displayed
9	as required for a standard issue and will be the sole plate
10	issued/assigned to the vehicle. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall
11	determine, by rule, a method for making required fee adjustments
12	when a special or personalized license plate is obtained during a
13	twelve-month period for which a registration fee has already been
14	remitted pursuant to this subsection. The combination of fees in a

17 For all-terrain vehicles and motorcycles used exclusively Β. 18 for use off roads or highways purchased on or after July 1, 2005, 19 and for all-terrain vehicles and motorcycles used exclusively for 20 use off roads or highways purchased prior to July 1, 2005, which the 21 owner chooses to register pursuant to the provisions of Section 22 1115.3 of this title, an initial and nonrecurring registration fee 23 of Eleven Dollars (\$11.00) shall be assessed at the time of initial 24 registration by the owner. Nine Dollars (\$9.00) of the registration _ _

¹ fee shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement ² Fund. Two Dollars (\$2.00) of the registration fee shall be retained ³ by the motor license agent. The fees required by subsection A of ⁴ this section shall not be required for all-terrain vehicles or ⁵ motorcycles used exclusively off roads and highways.

6 C. For utility vehicles used exclusively for use off roads or 7 highways purchased on or after July 1, 2008, and for utility 8 vehicles used exclusively for use off roads or highways purchased 9 prior to July 1, 2008, which the owner chooses to register pursuant 10 to the provisions of Section 1115.3 of this title, an initial and 11 nonrecurring registration fee of Eleven Dollars (\$11.00) shall be 12 assessed at the time of initial registration by the owner. Nine 13 Dollars (\$9.00) of the registration fee shall be deposited in the 14 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund. Two Dollars (\$2.00) of 15 the registration fee shall be retained by the motor license agent. 16 The fees required by subsection A of this section shall not be 17 required for utility vehicles used exclusively off roads and 18 highways.

D. There shall be a credit allowed with respect to the fee for registration of a new vehicle which is a replacement for:

21 1. A new original vehicle which is stolen from the 22 purchaser/registrant within ninety (90) days of the date of purchase 23 of the original vehicle as certified by a police report or other 24 documentation as required by the Oklahoma Tax Commission; or

1 2. A defective new original vehicle returned by the 2 purchaser/registrant to the seller within six (6) months of the date 3 of purchase of the defective new original vehicle as certified by 4 the manufacturer.

The credit shall be in the amount of the fee for registration which was paid for the new original vehicle and shall be applied to the registration fee for the replacement vehicle. In no event will the credit be refunded.

9 Upon every transfer or change of ownership of a vehicle, the Ε. 10 new owner shall obtain title for and, except in the case of salvage 11 vehicles and manufactured homes, register the vehicle within thirty 12 (30) days of change of ownership and pay a transfer fee of Fifteen 13 Dollars (\$15.00) in addition to any other fees provided for in this 14 act the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. No new decal 15 shall be issued to the registrant. Thereafter, the owner shall 16 register the vehicle annually on the anniversary date of its initial 17 registration in this state and shall pay the fees provided in 18 subsection A of this section and receive a decal evidencing such 19 payment. Provided, used motor vehicle dealers shall be exempt from 20 the provisions of this section.

F. In the event a new or used vehicle is not registered, titled and tagged within thirty (30) days from the date of transfer of ownership, the penalty for the failure of the owner of the vehicle to register the vehicle within thirty (30) days shall be One Dollar

(\$1.00) per day, provided that in no event shall the penalty exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00). No penalty shall be waived by the Oklahoma Tax Commission or any motor license agent except as provided in subsection C of Section 1127 of this title. Of each dollar penalty collected pursuant to this subsection:

6 1. Twenty-one cents (\$0.21) shall be apportioned as provided in 7 Section 1104 of this title;

8 2. Twenty-one cents (\$0.21) shall be retained by the motor 9 license agent; and

10 3. Fifty-eight cents (\$0.58) shall be deposited in the General 11 Revenue Fund.

SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.1, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 26, O.S.L. 2016 (47 O.S. Supp. 2020, Section 1135.1), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1135.1. A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license plates to persons as provided by this section.

Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been registered for the current year.

Except as provided in subsection B of this section, special
License plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax Commission or a

1 motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall annually notify by 2 mail all persons issued special license plates. The notice shall 3 contain all necessary information and shall contain instructions for 4 the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor license agent or 5 the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be issued on a 6 staggered system. The motor license agent fees shall be paid out of 7 the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

On and after January 1, 2022, if a special license plate is 9 issued pursuant to this section, any registration fee required for 10 such plate pursuant to this section and the fee required pursuant to 11 Section 1132 of this title shall be remitted at the same time and 12 subject to a single registration period. The Oklahoma Tax 13 Commission shall determine, by rule, a method for making required 14 fee and registration period adjustments if a special license plate 15 is obtained during a twelve-month period for which a registration 16 fee has already been remitted pursuant to Section 1132 of this 17 title. The combination of fees in a single remittance shall not 18 alter the apportionment otherwise provided for in this section. 19 The special license plates provided by this section are as в. 20 follows: 21 1. Political Subdivision Plates - such plates shall be designed

22 for any vehicle owned by any political subdivision of this state 23 having obtained a proper Oklahoma certificate of title. Such 24 political subdivisions shall file an annual report with the Tax _ _

Commission stating the agency where such vehicle is located. Such license plates shall be permanent in nature and designed in such a manner as to remain with the vehicle for the duration of the life span of the vehicle or until the title is transferred to an owner who is not a political subdivision.

The registration fee shall be Eight Dollars (\$8.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

9 2. Tax-Exempt or Nonprofit License Plates - such plates shall 10 be designed for:

- 11 any motor bus, manufactured home, or mobile chapel and a. 12 power unit owned and operated by a religious 13 corporation or society of this state holding a valid 14 exemption from taxation issued pursuant to Section 15 501(a) of the Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., 16 Section 501(a), and listed as an exempt organization 17 in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, as 18 amended, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), and that is 19 used by the corporation or society solely for the 20 furtherance of its religious functions, 21 b. any vehicle owned and operated only by nonprofit 22 organizations devoted exclusively to youth programs
 - including, but not limited to, the Girl Scouts and Boy Scouts of America,

1 any vehicle, except passenger automobiles, owned or с. 2 operated by nonprofit organizations actually involved 3 in programs for the employment of the handicapped and 4 used exclusively in the transportation of goods or 5 materials for such organization, 6 d. any vehicle owned and operated by a nonprofit 7 organization that provides older persons 8 transportation to and from medical, dental and 9 religious services and relief from business and social 10 isolation, 11 any vehicle owned and operated by a private nonprofit e. 12 organization that: 13 warehouses and distributes surplus foods to other (1)14 nonprofit agencies and organizations, and 15 (2) holds a valid exemption from taxation issued 16 pursuant to Section 501(c) of the Internal 17 Revenue Code, as amended, 26 U.S.C., Section 18 501(c), and listed as an exempt organization in 19 Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, 20 as amended, and 21 uses such vehicle exclusively for the (3) 22 transportation of such surplus foods, 23 f. any vehicle which: 24 _ _

1 is owned and operated by a private, nonprofit (1)2 organization which is exempt from taxation 3 pursuant to the provisions of Section 501(c)(3) 4 of the Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 5 501(c)(3), and which is primarily funded by a 6 fraternal or civic service organization with at 7 least one hundred local chapters or clubs, and 8 (2) is designed and used to provide mobile health 9 screening services to the general public at no 10 cost to the recipient, and for which no 11 reimbursement of any kind is received from any 12 health insurance provider, health maintenance 13 organization or governmental program, or 14 any vehicle owned and operated by the Civil Air q. 15 Patrol, a congressionally chartered corporation that 16 also serves an auxiliary of the United States Air 17 Force and which is exempt from taxation pursuant to 18 the provisions of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal 19 Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), and is 20 used exclusively for its corporate missions of 21 aerospace education, cadet programs and emergency 22 services. Such license plates shall be permanent in 23 nature and designed in such a manner as to remain with 24 the vehicle for the duration of the life span of the _ _

vehicle or until the title to such vehicle is transferred to an owner who is not subject to this exemption. Such vehicles shall be exempt from the registration fees levied under Section 1132 of this title, except that an initial registration fee of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) shall apply to each vehicle.

8 Any person claiming to be eligible for a tax-exempt or nonprofit 9 license plate under the provisions of this paragraph must have the 10 name of the tax-exempt or nonprofit organization prominently 11 displayed upon the outside of the vehicle, except those vehicles 12 registered pursuant to the provisions of subparagraph b of this 13 paragraph, unless such display is prohibited by federal or state law 14 or by state agency rules. No vehicle shall be licensed as a tax-15 exempt or nonprofit vehicle unless the vehicle has affixed on each 16 side thereof, in letters not less than two (2) inches high and two 17 (2) inches wide, the name of the tax-exempt or nonprofit 18 organization or the insignia or other symbol of such organization 19 which shall be of sufficient size, shape and color as to be readily 20 legible during daylight hours from a distance of fifty (50) feet 21 while the vehicle is not in motion.

Except as provided in subparagraph g of this paragraph, the registration fee shall be Eight Dollars (\$8.00) and shall be in

3 3. Physically Disabled License Plates - such plates shall be 4 designed for persons who are eligible for a physically disabled 5 placard under the provisions of Section 15-112 of this title. Ιt 6 shall prominently display the international accessibility symbol, 7 which is a stylized human figure in a wheelchair. The Tax 8 Commission shall also design physically disabled license plates for 9 motorcycles owned by persons who are eligible for a physically 10 disabled placard pursuant to the provisions of Section 15-112 of 11 this title. Upon the death of the physically disabled person, the 12 disabled license plate shall be returned to the Tax Commission. 13 There shall be no fee for such plate in addition to the rate 14 provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act for 15 the registration of the vehicle. For an additional fee of Ten 16 Dollars (\$10.00), a person eligible for a physically disabled 17 license plate shall have the option of purchasing a duplicate 18 physically disabled special license plate which shall be securely 19 attached to the front of the vehicle. The original physically 20 disabled special license plate shall be securely attached to the 21 rear of the vehicle at all times.

Any person who is eligible for a physically disabled license plate and whose vehicle has had modifications because of the physical disability of the owner or of a family member within the

second degree of consanguinity of the owner, may register the vehicle for a flat fee of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00). This fee shall be in lieu of all other registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;

4. Indian Tribal License Plates - such plates shall be designed
for any vehicle of a native American Indian Tribal Association
exempted in Sections 201 through 204 of Public Law 97-473 and used
by the tribal association exclusively for the furtherance of its
tribal functions.

The registration fee shall be Eight Dollars (\$8.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

13 5. Hearing Impaired License Plates - such plates shall be 14 designed for persons who are hearing impaired. Such persons may 15 apply for a hearing-impaired license plate for each vehicle with a 16 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon the presentment 17 of an application on a form furnished by the Tax Commission and 18 certified by a physician holding a valid license to practice 19 pursuant to the licensing provisions of Title 59 of the Oklahoma 20 Statutes, attesting that the person is hearing impaired. The 21 license plate shall be designed so that such persons may be readily 22 identified as being hearing impaired. There shall be no additional 23 fee for the plate, but all other registration fees provided by the 24 Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act shall apply; _ _

6. Antique or Classic Vehicles License Plates - such plates
 shall be designed and issued for any vehicle twenty-five (25) years
 of age or older, based upon the date of manufacture thereof and
 which travels on the highways of this state primarily incidental to
 historical or exhibition purposes only.

6 The registration fee shall be Eight Dollars (\$8.00) and shall be 7 in addition to all other registration fees provided by law, except 8 the registration fees levied by Section 1132 of this title. Any 9 person registering an antique or classic vehicle may elect to have 10 the vehicle registered for a ten-year period. The registration fee 11 for the elected ten-year registration shall be Seventy-five Dollars 12 (\$75.00). The motor license agent registering the antique or 13 classic vehicle for a ten-year period shall receive one hundred 14 percent (100%) of the fees the motor license agent would have 15 otherwise received pursuant to subsection A of Section 1141.1 of 16 this title if the antique or classic vehicle had been registered on 17 an annual basis; and

18 7. Honorary Consul License Plates - such plates shall be 19 designed to include the words "Honorary Consul" and issued to 20 persons who are honorary consuls authorized by the United States to 21 perform consular duties. Persons applying for such license plates 22 must show proof of standing as an honorary consul. The fee for such 23 plate shall be Eight Dollars (\$8.00) and shall be in addition to all 24 other registration fees required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and

Registration Act. The owner of the vehicle that possesses such license plates shall return the special license plates to the Oklahoma Tax Commission if the owner disposes of the vehicle during the registration year or ceases to be authorized to perform consular duties.

C. Special license plates provided by this section shall be
designed in such a manner as to identify the use or ownership of the
vehicle. Use of any vehicle possessing a special license plate
provided by this section for any purpose not specified herein shall
be grounds for revocation of the special license plate and
registration certificate.

D. The fees provided by this section shall be deposited in the
 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

SECTION 4. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.2, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 434, O.S.L. 2019 (47 O.S. Supp. 2020, Section 1135.2), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1135.2. A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license plates to persons in recognition of their service or awards as provided by this section.

Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used

1 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
2 registered for the current year.

3 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax 4 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall 5 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates. 6 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain 7 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor 8 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be 9 issued on a staggered system except for legislative plates and 10 amateur radio operator license plates.

11 On and after January 1, 2022, if a special license plate is 12 issued pursuant to this section, any registration fee required for 13 such plate pursuant to this section and the fee required pursuant to 14 Section 1132 of this title shall be remitted at the same time and 15 subject to a single registration period. The Oklahoma Tax 16 Commission shall determine, by rule, a method for making required 17 fee and registration period adjustments if a special license plate 18 is obtained during a twelve-month period for which a registration 19 fee has already been remitted pursuant to Section 1132 of this 20 title. The combination of fees in a single remittance shall not 21 alter the apportionment otherwise provided for in this section. 22 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a 23 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept 24 applications for special license plates authorized under this

1 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's 2 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount 3 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary 4 information directly into such system and generate a receipt 5 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents 6 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for 7 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for 8 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the 9 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

B. The special license plates provided by this section are as follows:

12 1. Prisoner of War License Plates - such plates shall be 13 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United 14 States Armed Forces and civilians who were former prisoners of war 15 held by a foreign country and who can provide proper certification 16 of that status. Such persons may apply for a prisoner of war 17 license plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having 18 a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving 19 spouse of any deceased former prisoner of war, if the spouse has not 20 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by 21 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a prisoner of war 22 license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one 23 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special 24 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to _ _

1 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
2 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

3 2. National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be 4 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma National 5 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide 6 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be 7 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

8 3. Air National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
9 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma Air National
10 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
11 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
12 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

13 4. United States Armed Forces - such plates shall be designed 14 for active, retired, former or reserve members of the United States 15 Armed Forces, and shall identify which branch of service, and carry 16 the emblem and name of either the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or 17 Coast Guard, according to the branch of service to which the member 18 belongs or did belong. Former members who have been dishonorably 19 discharged shall not be eligible for such plates. Persons applying 20 for such license plate must show proof of present or past military 21 service by presenting a valid Uniformed Services Identity Card or 22 the United States Department of Defense Form (DD)214. Retired or 23 former members who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof

1 of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required 2 to provide proof of eligibility annually;

5. Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient License Plates - such
plates shall be designed for any resident of this state who has been
awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor. Such persons may apply
for a Congressional Medal of Honor recipient license plate for each
vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
There shall be no registration fee for the issuance of this plate;

9 6. Missing In Action License Plates - such plates shall be 10 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who are 11 missing in action. The spouse of such missing person, if the spouse 12 has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is 13 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, and each parent of the 14 missing person may apply for a missing in action license plate upon 15 presenting proper certification that the person is missing in action 16 and that the person making the application is the qualifying spouse 17 or the parent of the missing person. The qualifying spouse and each 18 parent of the missing person may each apply for the missing in 19 action license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity 20 of one (1) ton or less;

Purple Heart Recipient License Plates - such plates shall be
 designed for any resident of this state presenting proper

Unless otherwise 4 provided in this section, Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) of the fee shall 5 be apportioned as follows: Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the special 6 license plate fee shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission 7 Reimbursement Fund to be used for the administration of the Oklahoma 8 Vehicle License and Registration Act and the remaining amounts of 9 the special license plate fee shall be apportioned as provided in 10 Section 1104 of this title.

D. The fee for special license plates that provide financial assistance shall be determined in accordance with Section 1 of this act <u>1135.9 of this title</u>. Provided, the fee shall be no less than Thirty-five Dollars (\$35.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. Thirty-five Dollars (\$35.00) per year of renewal of the fee shall be apportioned as follows:

18 1. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee shall be apportioned to 19 the License Plate Special Program Assistance Revolving Fund created 20 in Section 1135.8 of this title to be used in the manner detailed in 21 the application for the special license plate;

22 2. Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the fee shall be deposited in the
 23 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the

1 administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;

3. Any remaining amounts of the fee shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104 of this title.

5 If a person applies for a special license plate that Ε. 6 provides financial assistance, the application shall designate a 7 state agency to be responsible for expending the funds generated by 8 the special license plate and the application shall designate a 9 specific public purpose for which the funds are to be used. The 10 application shall include an acknowledgment from the designated 11 state agency of their agreement with acceptance of the designated 12 funds.

F. Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been registered for the current year.

Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax Commission or a motor license agent, unless authorized by the Tax Commission to be renewed for a period greater than one (1) year. The Tax Commission shall notify all persons issued special license plates of the renewal procedures prior to the expiration of the special license plate. The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure

upon presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be issued on a staggered system.

3	On and after January 1, 2022, if a special license plate is
4	issued pursuant to this section, any registration fee required for
5	such plate and the fee required pursuant to Section 1132 of this

7	registration period. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall determine,

The balance of the funds collected shall be remitted to the Oklahoma Tax Commission as provided in Section 1142 of this title to be apportioned pursuant to Section 1104 of this title.

For each certificate of registration issued for boats and 5 motors, each motor license agent shall be entitled to retain the 6 greater of One Dollar and twenty-five cents (\$1.25) or an amount to 7 be determined by the Tax Commission according to the provisions of 8 this subsection. At the end of fiscal year 1997 and each fiscal 9 year thereafter, the Tax Commission shall compute the average amount 10 of registration fees for all boats and motors registered in this 11 state during the fiscal year and shall multiply the result by six 12 and twenty-two one-hundredths percent (6.22%). The resulting 13 product shall be the amount which may be retained by each motor 14 license agent for each certificate of registration for boats and 15 motors issued during the following calendar year. 16 This act shall become effective January 1, 2022.
