6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Office of Management and
8 Enterprise Services; requiring the Director to
9 initiate a request for proposal; establishing purpose
10 of request; describing subject of request for
11 proposal; authorizing OMES to enter contract for
12 services; requiring OMES to provide notice;
13 establishing criteria for awarding of contract;
14 directing promulgation of rules; providing for
15 codification; and providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 34.204 of Title 62, unless there
19 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 A. By December 31, 2022, the Director of the Office of
21 Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) shall initiate a request
22 for proposal for the rationalization and determination of which
23 state applications and databases can be immediately transferred to a
24 cloud-based data storage platform. The purpose of this request for
25 proposal is to give this state the ability to accurately evaluate
26 the cost and plans needed to implement modernization of the state's

1 applications and databases. These applications and databases shall
2 be limited to customer relationship management tools, case
3 management tools, workflow tools and supplemental financial systems.
4 OMES is authorized to enter into a contract for such services,
5 pursuant to the provisions of law.

6 B. Notice of the request for proposal shall be published in the
7 manner provided for competitive bidding. The contract shall be
8 awarded to the responsible offeror whose proposal is determined to
9 achieve the desired goal of rationalization of technology for the
10 state.

11 C. The Director shall promulgate rules and establish procedures
12 to implement the request for proposal pursuant to the section.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
