21	confirming a diagnosis or treatment plan; and
22	2. "Telemedicine" means the practice of health care delivery,
23	diagnosis, consultation, evaluation and treatment, transfer of

of a two-way, real-time interactive communication, not to exclude store and forward technologies, between a patient and a physician with access to and reviewing the patient's relevant clinical information prior to the telemedicine visit. "Telemedicine" and "store and forward technologies" shall not include consultations provided by telephone audio-only communication, electronic mail, text message, instant messaging conversation, adaptive website questionnaire, nonsecure or secure video conference or facsimile machine.
