20	child or dependent accompanying such voters and other persons
21	authorized by law, shall be allowed inside the election enclosure
22	within fifty (50) feet of any ballot box the entrance to a polling
23	place or in-person absentee voting site while an election is in

8	question that is on the ballot at the election, either
9	verbally or with visual materials, signs or clothing,

11	b. collecting signatures for a petition to place an issue
12	or question on a future ballot; and
13	2. "Election enclosure" means the areas of a polling place
14	where voters sign the precinct registry and are issued ballots,
15	where voting booths are located, where a voting device or ballot box
16	is located, and any room, hallway or other space wherein such
17	activities take place.
18	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
