SENATE JOINT  
RESOLUTION 1XX

AS INTRODUCED

A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State to refer to the people for their approval or rejection a proposed amendment to Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution; authorizing levy for the purposes of protecting students from violence; providing for transfer of collections and apportionment to school districts; authorizing the Legislature to enact laws and provide for eligible expenditures; providing ballot title; and directing filing.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE  
2ND EXTRAORDINARY SESSION OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law, the following proposed amendment to Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution by adding a new Section 10C to read as follows:

Section 10C. A. A tax of one (1) mill on the dollar valuation of all taxable property in each county shall be levied annually for the purpose of protecting the students of school districts from violence. The proceeds of the levy shall be transferred to the Oklahoma Tax Commission and apportioned to the school districts in

1 this state on the basis of the legal average daily attendance for  
2 the preceding school year as certified by the State Board of  
3 Education.

4 B. The Legislature may enact laws to carry out the provisions  
5 of this section and to provide for eligible expenditures for  
6 protecting students from violence.

7 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional  
8 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in  
9 the following form:

12 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

13 This measure amends Article 10 of the Oklahoma Constitution by  
14 adding a new Section 10C, which authorizes the levy of a tax of  
15 one mill on the taxable property in the counties of this state  
16 for the purpose of providing protection for students from  
17 violence. The proceeds from the levy shall be transferred to  
18 the Oklahoma Tax Commission and apportioned to the school  
19 districts in this state on the basis of the legal average daily  
20 attendance for the preceding school year as certified by the  
21 State Board of Education.
