19	WHEREAS, along with her standing committees, David has also
20	served as the chair of the Grand River Dam Authority Legislative
21	Task Force; vice-chair of the Governor's Impaired Driving Prevention
22	Advisory Council; and as a member of the Legislative Office of
23	Fiscal Transparency Oversight Committee, the Joint Committee on
24	Pandemic Relief Funding, the Oklahoma Hydrogen Task Force, the

3 WHEREAS, she has been a strong advocate for Oklahoma's law 4 enforcement community, veterans, and first responders, helping 5 improve their training and providing them better mental health 6 support. She also authored laws providing comprehensive health care 7 for the elderly while also protecting victims of human trafficking, 8 domestic violence, child abuse, and stalking. She fought tirelessly 9 for state employees, modernizing their benefit system and protecting 10 the rights of nursing mothers at state agencies. Her work also 11 created open carry, the Pay-for-Success program to help lower female 12 incarceration, and the Impaired Driving Accountability Program; and 13 WHEREAS, State Question No. 632, adopted September 18, 1990, and 14 effective January 1, 1991, limits the length of service for a member 15 of the Legislature to a total of twelve years. As a result, Senator 16 David will not be eligible to stand for reelection this year; and

WHEREAS, Senator David has proudly and diligently represented the voices of Cherokee, Mayes, Muskogee, Tulsa, and Wagoner Counties, and her professionalism and determination will be greatly missed at the Oklahoma Capitol and within the esteemed Senate.
