AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, strike the title, enacting clause and
entire bill and insert

"An Act relating to prisons and reformatories;
directing the Department of Corrections to create and
establish an Orange Alert communication system;
requiring posting of information about the
communication system in local newspaper; requiring
residents to register for notifications; directing
the Department to promulgate policies; providing for
codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 701 of Title 57, unless there is
3 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 A. The Department of Corrections shall create for each
5 correctional facility within this state an "Orange Alert"
6 communication system to notify any resident within a radius of forty
7 (40) miles when a prisoner of a correctional facility has escaped.
8 Information regarding how to register for an Orange Alert via the
9 communication system shall be posted in a newspaper of record within
10 the county in which the correctional facility is located. It shall
11 be the responsibility of each resident to register to receive Orange
12 Alert notifications from the communication system.

13 B. The Department of Corrections shall promulgate policies for
14 establishing a statewide Orange Alert communication system.

15 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023."

23 newspaper of record within the county in which the facility is
24 located. It shall be the responsibility of each resident to

register to receive "Orange Alert" notifications from the communication system.

B. The Department of Corrections shall promulgate policies for establishing a statewide "Orange Alert" communication system.

SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
