codification; and providing an effective date.

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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

20 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 8-101 of Title 37A, unless there
22 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 The Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement (ABLE) Commission is
24 hereby authorized to establish official advanced funds (OAF) for the

purpose of supplying its agents with money for enforcement of actions to obtain critical evidence for case presentations. The amount of the OAF shall not exceed Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), and the ABLE Commission is authorized to prescribe forms, systems, and procedures for its administration. The OAF may be reimbursed from time to time by the filing of proper claims, accompanied by valid receipts for expenditures made.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023."

14 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 8-101 of Title 37A, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 There is hereby created a petty cash fund for the Alcoholic
18 Beverage Laws Enforcement (ABLE) Commission to be used for the
19 purpose of supplying its agents with money for undercover operations
20 to obtain critical evidence for case presentations. The amount of
21 the petty cash fund shall not exceed Five Thousand Dollars
22 (\$5,000.00), and the ABLE Commission is authorized to prescribe
23 forms, systems, and procedures for its administration. The petty
24

1 cash fund may be reimbursed from time to time by the filing of
2 proper claims, accompanied by valid receipts for expenditures made.

3 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
