15 provider credentialing process; modifying
applicability of certain provisions; updating
16 statutory language; directing Oklahoma Health Care
Authority to establish certain processes; providing
17 for codification; and providing an effective date.

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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2021, Section 1-106.2, is
22 amended to read as follows:

23 Section 1-106.2 A. ~~By January 1, 1999, the~~ The State Board
24 Commissioner of Health shall promulgate rules necessary to develop a

1 uniform application which shall be used in the credentialing process
2 of health care providers. The State Department of Health shall
3 develop such application form for:

4 1. Initial privileges or membership in a hospital, ~~managed care~~
5 ~~organization~~, or other entity requiring credentials verification,
6 except for a contracted entity as defined by Section 4002.2 of Title
7 56 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and

8 2. Recredentialing or reappointment in a hospital, ~~managed care~~
9 ~~organization~~, or other entity requiring credentials verification,
10 except for a contracted entity as defined by Section 4002.2 of Title
11 56 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

12 B. Any entity requiring credentials verification may require
13 supplemental information.

14 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5071 of Title 63, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall establish and maintain
18 for providers of Medicaid services:

19 1. A provider enrollment and credentialing process for
20 providers who receive fee-for-service reimbursement under the state
21 Medicaid program; and

22 2. A single consolidated provider enrollment and credentialing
23 process, in accordance with subsection D of Section 4002.4 of Title
24 56 of the Oklahoma Statutes and 42 C.F.R., Section 438.214, for

providers who enter into capitated contracts with contracted entities under the Ensuring Access to Medicaid Act.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023."

22 2. Recredentialing or reappointment in a hospital, managed care
23 organization, or other entity requiring credentials verification.
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1 B. Any entity requiring credentials verification may require
2 supplemental information.

3 C. Notwithstanding any other provision in this section, the
4 Oklahoma Health Care Authority, as the single state agency for
5 Medicaid, shall establish and maintain for providers of Medicaid
6 services:

7 1. A streamlined provider enrollment and credentialing process
8 for any Medicaid fee-for-service delivery system; and

9 2. A single consolidated provider enrollment and credentialing
10 process for a managed care delivery system in accordance with
11 subsection D of Section 4002.4 of Title 56 of the Oklahoma Statutes
12 and 42 C.F.R., Section 438.214.

13 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
