21 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, restore the title

22 AMENDMENT NO. 2. Page 2, line 5, delete the brackets "[]" and
23 insert the following:

1 "A tract of land lying in the Northeast Quarter (NE/4) and the
2 Northwest Quarter (NW/4) of Section Twenty-seven (27), Township
3 Twelve (12) North, Range Three (3) West of the Indian Meridian,
4 Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, being more particularly described as
5 follows: COMMENCING at the Northwest corner of the NE/4 of said
6 Section 27; thence S00°07'01"E along the West line of said NE/4 a
7 distance of 1436.71 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING; thence
8 N89°50'42"E a distance of 123.31 feet; thence S04°59'53"W a distance
9 of 309.96 feet; thence S89°50'42"W a distance of 194.19 feet; thence
10 N05°20'12"W a distance of 309.98 feet; thence N89°50'42"E a distance
11 of 126.71 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING. Containing 68,567.88
12 Square Feet or 1.574 Acres, more or less."

13 AMENDMENT NO. 3. Page 2, line 13, insert a new Section 2 to read as
14 follows:

15 "SECTION 2. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a
16 revolving fund for the Office of Management and Enterprise Services
17 to be designated the "State Capitol Arch Maintenance Revolving
18 Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal
19 year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the
20 Office of Management and Enterprise Services from appropriations,
21 donations, gifts and bequests by individuals, corporations,
22 organizations, associations and foundations provided for the purpose
23 of maintenance of the Oklahoma Capitol Arch. All monies accruing to
24 the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted

1 and expended by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for
2 the purpose provided for in this section. Expenditures from the
3 fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer
4 against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the
5 Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and
6 payment.”

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 401 of Title 73, unless there is
19 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 A. The Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority shall allocate
21 the sum of Four Million Three Hundred Thousand Dollars
22 (\$4,300,000.00) from the Legacy Capital Financing Fund for purposes
23 of the design and construction of the State Capitol Arch the purpose
24

1 of which is to honor and memorialize the services performed by the
2 Oklahoma National Guard.

3 B. The State Capitol Arch shall be constructed upon the
4 following described parcel of real property:

5 []

6 C. The State Capitol Preservation Commission shall enter into
7 contract with such person, persons, or lawfully recognized entities
8 as may be required in order to construct the State Capitol Arch
9 according to preliminary design documents as prepared by the
10 Architect of the State Capitol.

11 D. The provisions of Section 187B of Title 73 of the Oklahoma
12 Statutes shall be applicable to the project.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

14 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
15 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
16 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
17 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
