NEW LAW 17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 18q-1 of Title 74, unless there 18 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 19 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving 20 fund for the Office of the Attorney General to be designated the 21 "Federal Overreach and Extraordinary Litigation Revolving Fund". 22 The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year 23 limitations, and shall consist of all monies eligible and designated 24 for deposit by law. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund
