15 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the title, enacting clause, and entire bill
16 and insert:

18 "An Act relating to ports; amending 82 O.S. 2021,
19 Section 1141, which relates to the McClellan-Kerr
20 Arkansas River Navigation System Infrastructure
21 Revolving Fund; redesignating fund as the Oklahoma
22 Ports Infrastructure Revolving Fund; modifying
23 conditions for access of the fund; defining term;
24 granting certain authority to the Department of
Transportation for use of fund; requiring
promulgation of rules; updating statutory reference;
and providing an effective date.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

2 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 82 O.S. 2021, Section 1141, is
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Section 1141. A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury
5 a revolving fund for the ~~Oklahoma~~ Department of Transportation to be
6 designated the "~~McClellan-Kerr Arkansas River Navigation System~~
7 Oklahoma Ports Infrastructure Revolving Fund (OPIRF)". The fund
8 shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations,
9 for the purpose of pooling all monies received by the ~~Oklahoma~~
10 Department of Transportation from appropriations, dedicated
11 revenues, federal funds, private contributions or other sources
12 authorized by law dedicated to the McClellan-Kerr Arkansas River
13 Navigation System (MKARNS) or the waterway ports of this state.
14 Such monies shall include but not be limited to:

15 1. Monies received by the Department of Transportation for
16 waterway projects or infrastructure projects at waterway ports;

17 2. Principal and interest and penalty payments on loans made
18 directly from appropriated monies in the fund; and

19 3. Any other sums deposited into the fund from any public or
20 private source.

21 All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby
22 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the ~~Oklahoma~~
23 Department of Transportation for qualified projects upon a
24 ~~recommendation by the Waterways Advisory Board of~~ review by the

1 ~~Oklahoma Department of Transportation and upon consultation with all~~
2 ~~Native American tribes with an ownership interest in the Arkansas~~
3 ~~riverbed for the purpose of repairing or constructing assets which~~
4 ~~are part of the MKARNS located in the State of Oklahoma which are~~
5 ~~essential to the safe and efficient operation of such system and may~~
6 ~~also be used to match federal grants and awards associated with~~
7 ~~channel improvements of the MKARNS, whether due to natural~~
8 ~~disasters, emergency conditions, operations and maintenance needs or~~
9 ~~construction projects~~ approval from the Transportation Commission.
10 Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the
11 State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the
12 Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for
13 approval and payment.

14 B. The monies placed in the OPIRF shall be invested by the
15 State Treasurer as prescribed by Section 89.2 of Title 62 of the
16 Oklahoma Statutes. Notwithstanding any other provision of law,
17 income and earnings on the fund shall accrue to the fund and may be
18 used for the purposes provided for in this section. Any interest
19 earned by the State Treasurer from such funds invested shall be
20 deposited in the OPIRF.

21 C. As used in this section, a "qualified project" shall:

22 1. Enhance the safe and efficient operation of the commercial
23 waterway systems of this state; or
24

1 2. Repair, improve, or construct waterway or industrial park
2 infrastructure located at or within waterway ports of this state
3 that are determined to provide a public benefit.

4 Such projects shall be developed in consultation with the United
5 States Army Corps of Engineers and all Indian tribes with an
6 ownership interest in the riverbed of the Arkansas River when
7 necessary.

8 D. The OPIRF may be utilized by port authorities which have
9 active waterway ports in this state for pooling available federal,
10 private, and state monies for capital projects at their ports for
11 purposes authorized by Section 1106 of this title.

12 E. The Department of Transportation shall:

13 1. Grant or make loans from the OPIRF for qualified projects in
14 order to implement the provisions of this section;

15 2. Grant an amount not to exceed twenty percent (20%) of the
16 funds available in the OPIRF during any one (1) year for qualified
17 projects; and

18 3. Loan an amount not to exceed thirty-five percent (35%) of
19 the funds available in the OPIRF during any one (1) year for
20 qualified projects.

21 No less than ten percent (10%) of the funds available in the
22 OPIRF during any one (1) year shall be reserved for emergency
23 repairs to ports or waterway infrastructure as authorized by the
24 Transportation Commission. Such determination of ten percent (10%)

1 shall be made based off of the funds available in the OPIRF at the
2 start of each calendar year.

3 F. The Department of Transportation shall promulgate rules
4 necessary to effectuate the provisions of this section. The
5 Department of Transportation shall also promulgate rules to ensure
6 that any grants or loans made from the OPIRF are made at market-
7 competitive terms.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective January 1, 2025."

20 SECTION 4. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of
21 Transportation from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
22 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
23 ending June 30, 2023, the sum of Sixteen Million Two Hundred
24 Thousand Dollars (\$16,200,000.00) or so much thereof as may be

1 necessary to transfer to the Oklahoma Ports Infrastructure Revolving
2 Fund created pursuant to Section 1141 of Title 82 of the Oklahoma
3 Statutes.

4 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective January 1, 2025.
