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7 An Act relating to public health; amending 63 O.S.
8 2021, Section 7301, which relates to diabetes
9 prevention reporting; modifying reporting period;
10 requiring submission to Governor; requiring
11 submission of components of report under certain
12 conditions; updating statutory language; updating
13 statutory references; and providing an effective
14 date.

14 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 3, Line 12 1/2, insert the following
15 language:

16 "SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2065 of Title 63, unless there
18 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving
20 fund for the State Department of Health to be designated the "School
21 Nurse Pilot Program Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing
22 fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of
23 all monies designated for and eligible for deposit under law. All
24 monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby appropriated

1 and may be budgeted and expended by the State Department of Health
2 to facilitate the implementation of a pilot program as described in
3 subsection B of this section including but not limited to the
4 distribution of such funds through grants administered by the
5 Department or in coordination with the Department. Expenditures
6 from said fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State
7 Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the
8 Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for
9 approval and payment.

10 B. The State Department of Health shall utilize funds deposited
11 to the School Nurse Pilot Program Revolving Fund for the purpose of
12 implementing a pilot program to deliver school nurse services that
13 address health, mental health, and social services needs of students
14 and families to promote the ability for students to have the best
15 opportunity to learn and be successful in their public school
16 district. Such pilot program shall include the following criteria
17 and limitations:

18 1. Encompass a contiguous three-county area with no more than
19 twenty percent (20%) of the area's school districts having
20 enrollments greater than three thousand (3,000) weighted average
21 daily membership as calculated by the State Department of Education
22 the year of the pilot program's inception; and

23 2. Have consolidated implementation coordinated by a single
24 nonprofit provider.

1 C. The State Department of Health may promulgate rules and
2 adopt policies and procedures as required to administer the
3 provisions of this section."

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2021, Section 7301, is
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 7301. A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority and the
18 State Department of Health shall collaborate to identify benchmarks
19 and develop goals to reduce the incidence rates of, improve health
20 care services for, and control complications resulting from
21 diabetes.

22 B. The Authority and the Department shall submit a report to
23 the President Pro Tempore of the Senate ~~and,~~ the Speaker of the
24 House of Representatives, and the Governor by ~~January 10th of odd-~~
~~numbered years~~ January 10 of every fifth year. Such report shall
contain the following information:

1 1. The fiscal impact of all types of diabetes on the Authority,
2 the Department, and county health departments including the number
3 of persons with diabetes receiving services through the Authority,
4 the Department, and county health departments;

5 2. The fiscal impact of diabetes on the Authority, the
6 Department, and county health departments in comparison to other
7 chronic diseases;

8 3. An assessment of the benefits of diabetes prevention
9 programs including a summary of funding directed to the Authority
10 and the Department from the ~~Oklahoma State~~ Legislature;

11 4. A description of coordination between the Authority and the
12 Department including, but not limited to, programs relating to the
13 treatment and prevention of all forms of diabetes;

14 5. Detailed action plans for battling diabetes with actionable
15 items for consideration by the Legislature including, but not
16 limited to, steps to reduce the impact of diabetes, pre-diabetes,
17 and related diabetes complications;

18 6. Identification of expected outcomes of the action steps and
19 benchmarks for controlling and preventing all forms of diabetes; and

20 7. The development of a detailed budget blueprint identifying
21 needs, costs, and resources required to implement the plan provided
22 for in this ~~act~~ section. Such blueprint shall include a budget
23 range for all options presented in the plan for consideration by the
24 Legislature.

1 C. In addition to the complete report required by subsection B
2 of this section, the Authority or the Department shall, to the
3 extent practicable, provide components of the upcoming report as
4 listed in subsection B of this section upon request to the President
5 Pro Tempore of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of
6 Representatives, and the Governor.

7 D. The provisions of this ~~act~~ section shall be limited to
8 diabetes information, data, initiatives, and programs within the
9 Authority and the Department prior to ~~the effective date of this act~~
10 November 1, 2015, unless there is available funding for diabetes in
11 each agency that may be used for new research, data collection
12 reporting or other requirements of this ~~act~~ section.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
