13 codification; and providing an effective date.

13 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 2, Section 1, Line 6 1/2, insert the  
14 following language:

15 "D. The Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority shall promulgate  
16 rules necessary to allow for pre-packaged products to be returned to  
17 the licensed medical marijuana dispensary when found defective or  
18 hazardous to the health of the patient. The Authority shall further  
19 promulgate rules necessary to allow for the return of medical  
20 marijuana products from a licensed medical marijuana dispensary to a  
21 licensed medical marijuana processor or licensed medical marijuana  
22 commercial grower, from a licensed medical marijuana processor to a  
23 licensed medical marijuana commercial grower, or from any other  
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1 licensed entity that transferred medical marijuana products to  
2 another licensed entity."

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6 An act relating to medical marijuana; directing  
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12 codification; and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 431.1 of Title 63, unless there  
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. Upon the effective date of this act, all medical marijuana  
18 flower, trim, shake, kief, medical marijuana product, or other  
19 flower-based product not defined as a concentrate, shall be sold by  
20 licensed medical marijuana processors and licensed medical marijuana  
21 commercial growers to licensed medical marijuana dispensaries only  
22 in pre-packaged form in package sizes weighing not less than one-  
23 half (1/2) of one (1) gram to not more than three (3) ounces.

24 B. Nonopaque materials may be used when packaging medical  
marijuana flower provided all other packaging and labeling

1 requirements for medical marijuana products sold in this state are  
2 met and it is placed in an opaque container before leaving a  
3 licensed medical marijuana dispensary.

4 C. The display and smelling of medical marijuana shall be  
5 allowed pursuant to Section 421 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma  
6 Statutes.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
