NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-9-111 of Title 27A, unless 13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 14 On or before January 1, 2025, the Department of Environmental 15 Quality, in coordination with the Office of the Secretary of Energy 16 and Environment, shall conduct a study pursuant to this section. 17 The study shall focus on the feasibility of establishing nuclear 18 facilities to be located in this state.
