PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to public health and safety;  
directing the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to  
establish an enrollment process for certain  
providers; providing for codification; and providing  
an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5020.1 of Title 63, unless there  
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall establish an  
enrollment process for providers whose only relationship with the  
Oklahoma Medicaid program is for ordering and/or referring services.

B. This enrollment process will allow a physician or non-  
physician practitioner, who does not submit claims for services  
provided to Medicaid beneficiaries, to participate in the Oklahoma  
Medicaid program, solely for the purpose of ordering and referring.

1 C. The enrollment process established by the Authority shall  
2 not exceed the requirements as stipulated by the Medicare CMS-8550  
3 application.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
