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16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 37A O.S. 2021, Section 2-103, is
18	amended to read as follows:
19	Section 2-103. A. A distiller license shall authorize the
20	holder thereof:
21	1. To manufacture, bottle, package and store spirits on
22	licensed premises;
23	2. To sell spirits in this state to licensed wholesalers and
24	manufacturers only;

To sell spirits out of this state to qualified persons; to
 purchase from licensed distillers and rectifiers in this state, and
 import spirits from without this state for manufacturing purposes in
 accordance with federal laws and regulations;

5 4. To serve free samples of spirits produced only by the licensee to visitors twenty-one (21) years of age and older. For 6 7 purposes of this section, no visitor may sample more than a total of three (3) fluid ounces of spirits per day. The distiller shall 8 9 restrict the distribution and consumption of spirits samples to an 10 area within the licensed premises designated by the distiller. A 11 current floor plan that includes the designated sampling area shall be on file with the ABLE Commission. No visitor under twenty-one 12 13 (21) years of age shall be permitted to enter the designated 14 sampling area when samples are being distributed and consumed. 15 Samples of spirits served by a distiller under this section shall 16 not be considered a sale of spirits within the meaning of Article 17 XXVIII-A of the Oklahoma Constitution or Section 1-103 of this 18 title; provided, such samples of spirits shall be considered removed 19 or withdrawn from the distillery for use or consumption within the 20 meaning of Section 5-110 of this title for excise tax determination 21 and reporting requirements;

5. To sell spirits produced by the licensee for either onpremises or off-premises consumption to consumers on the licensed distillery premises or in an area controlled by the licensee located

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1 contiguous to the licensed distillery premises <u>and at one (1)</u>
2 <u>location controlled by the licensee located not contiguous to the</u>
3 <u>licensed distillery premises</u>. <u>Product Spirits</u> offered for sale by
4 the Oklahoma licensed distiller will have been sold to and shipped
5 to an Oklahoma licensed wine and spirits wholesaler and then made
6 available for purchase by the Oklahoma licensed distiller for sale;
7 and

6. To sell spirits at public events such as trade shows or
9 festivals. Products offered for sale by the Oklahoma licensed
10 distiller will have been sold to and shipped to an Oklahoma licensed
11 wine and spirits wholesaler and then made available for purchase by
12 the Oklahoma licensed distiller.

B. Spirits sold pursuant to paragraphs 5 and 6 of subsection A
of this section shall not exceed fifteen thousand (15,000) gallons
per calendar year in combination.

<u>C. Spirits sold pursuant to paragraphs 5 and 6 of subsection A</u>
<u>of this section, when mixed with other non-alcoholic substances,</u>
<u>shall not be considered cocktails, mixed beverages or mixed drinks.</u>
<u>Substances used for on premise consumption shall be non-alcoholic in</u>
<u>nature and shall not be considered part of the manufacturing</u>
<u>process.</u>

22 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 23 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby

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1	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
