14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-104.4a of Title 70, unless
16	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	Upon the effective date of this act, there shall be a moratorium
18	on additional accreditation rules approved and imposed upon school
19	districts by the State Board of Education without specific
20	legislative statutory authorization. The Office of Educational
21	Quality and Accountability shall conduct a review and prepare a
22	report of all statutes and rules utilized by the State Board of
23	Education and State Department of Education to determine
24	accreditation standards and deficiencies and submit the report to

the President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State Senate, the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives, the Chair of the Senate Education Committee, Chair of the Senate Education Appropriations Subcommittee, Chair of the House Common Education Committee, and Chair of the House Education Appropriations and Budget Subcommittee no later than January 1, 2024. SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval. 59-1-7405 02/13/23 EK
