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11 PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

12 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Capitol Improvement
13 Authority; providing for allocation of funds from the
14 Legacy Capital Financing Fund; authorizing
15 utilization of certain amount for the purpose of
16 benefitting the Oklahoma State Bureau of
17 Investigation; requiring certain recapitalization
18 payments; authorizing certain distributions;
19 authorizing and limiting utilization of memoranda of
20 understanding; providing for codification; providing
21 an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

23 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
24 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 187A-11 of Title 73, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. In addition to any other authorization provided by law, the
Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority is authorized to utilize

1 available funds from the Legacy Capital Financing Fund created by
2 Section 187B of Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes, in the amount of
3 Twenty-seven Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$27,500,000.00)
4 for the benefit of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation to
5 construct, refurbish, or expand the Oklahoma State Bureau of
6 Investigation headquarters and related facilities.

7 B. LCF Recapitalization Payments shall be made related to the
8 distribution of proceeds provided in subsection A of this section,
9 in accordance with the provisions of the Legacy Capital Financing
10 Act.

11 C. The Authority may distribute funds authorized pursuant to
12 subsection A of this section in one or more tranches.

13 D. The Authority may enter memoranda of understanding with
14 agencies, departments, and subdivisions of the state as needed, to
15 facilitate the provisions of this act, provided that such memoranda
16 of understanding do not constitute a legal obligation of the State
17 of Oklahoma or impede the administration of the provisions of the
18 Legacy Capital Financing Act.

19 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

20 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
21 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
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1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
