PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to the State Department of Health;
creating the Oklahoma Adolescent Psychiatric Facility
Grant Program; placing the program at a certain
agency; providing purpose; requiring certain reports;
establishing the Adolescent Psychiatric Facility
Revolving Fund; establishing fund nature; authorizing
certain budgeting and expenditure of funds for
certain purposes; providing for codification;
providing an effective date; and declaring an
emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3240.9 of Title 63, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma
Adolescent Psychiatric Facility Grant Program".

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3420.10 of Title 63, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 There is hereby created at the Adolescent Psychiatric Facility
2 Grant Program which shall be administered by the State Department of
3 Health. The program shall help increase the number of adolescent
4 psychiatric beds available in Oklahoma. The program shall help
5 provide funding for remodeling or building out existing facility
6 space to be used for an adolescent psychiatric facility. The
7 program shall be used for facilities where a Public Trust Hospital,
8 as defined in Sections 3250.1 through 3250.9 of Title 63 of the
9 Oklahoma Statutes, are donating both the space and the staffing
10 needs to support the facility. Applicants shall have, in writing,
11 the agreed upon support from the donating Public Trust Hospital upon
12 application. The location of these facilities shall be in counties
13 with a population of less than forty-five thousand (45,000) people
14 per the 2020 Federal Decennial Census. The facility, upon
15 completion, shall hold between ten and twenty beds for adolescent
16 psychiatric patients upon completion. Beginning January 1, 2025,
17 the State Department of Health shall provide an annual report to the
18 Governor, the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives, the
19 President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State Senate, the
20 Appropriations and Budget Chair of the Oklahoma House of
21 Representatives, and the Appropriations Chair of the State Senate
22 that includes information about any grants awarded and where
23 awardees are on the completion of the projects.

1 SECTION 3. A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma
2 Statutes as Section 3240.11 of Title 63, unless there is created a
3 duplication in numbering, reads as follows

4 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
5 for the State Department of Health to be designated the "Adolescent
6 Psychiatric Facility Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a
7 continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall
8 consist of all monies received by the State Department of Health
9 from appropriations to the fund. All monies accruing to the credit
10 of said fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and
11 expended by the State Department of Health for the purpose of the
12 Oklahoma Adolescent Psychiatric Facility Grant Program. The State
13 Department of Health may retain one percent (1%) of all funds
14 otherwise deposited to the fund to cover administrative costs
15 related to the Oklahoma Adolescent Psychiatric Facility Grant
16 Program. Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon warrants
17 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by
18 law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise
19 Services for approval and payment.

20 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

21 SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
22 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
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1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect
2 and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
