PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to medical marijuana; amending 63 O.S. 2021, Section 426.1, as amended by Section 6, Chapter 251, O.S.L. 2022 (63 O.S. Supp. 2023, Section 426.1), which relates to medical marijuana licensure revocations; certificate of compliance requirements; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2021, Section 426.1, as amended by Section 6, Chapter 251, O.S.L. 2022 (63 O.S. Supp. 2023, Section 426.1), is amended to read as follows:

Section 426.1 A. All licensure revocation hearings conducted pursuant to marijuana licenses established in the Oklahoma Statutes shall be recorded. A party may request a copy of the recording of the proceedings. Copies shall be provided to local law enforcement if the revocation was based on alleged criminal activity.

B. The Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority shall assist any law enforcement officer in the performance of his or her duties upon such request by the law enforcement officer or the request of other

1 local officials having jurisdiction. Except for license information
2 concerning licensed patients, as defined in Section 427.2 of this
3 title, the Authority shall share information with law enforcement
4 agencies upon request without a subpoena or search warrant.

5 C. The Authority shall make available all information on
6 whether or not a medical marijuana patient or caregiver license is
7 valid to law enforcement electronically through an online
8 verification system.

9 D. The Authority shall make available to state agencies and
10 political subdivisions a list of marijuana-licensed premises,
11 medical marijuana businesses or any other premises where marijuana
12 or its by-products are licensed to be cultivated, grown, processed,
13 stored or manufactured to aid state agencies and county and
14 municipal governments in identifying locations within their
15 jurisdiction and ensuring compliance with applicable laws, rules and
16 regulations.

17 ~~E. Any marijuana-licensed premises, medical marijuana business~~
18 ~~or any other premises where marijuana or its by products are~~
19 ~~licensed to be cultivated, grown, processed, stored or manufactured~~
20 ~~shall submit with its application or request to change location,~~
21 ~~after notifying the political subdivision of its intent, a~~
22 ~~certificate of compliance from the political subdivision where the~~

24 ~~compliance with zoning classifications, applicable municipal~~

3 ~~Once a certificate of compliance has been submitted to the~~
4 ~~Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority showing full compliance as~~
5 ~~outlined in this subsection, no additional certificate of compliance~~
6 ~~shall be required for license renewal unless a change of use or~~
7 ~~occupancy occurs, or there is any change concerning the facility or~~
8 ~~location that would, by law, require additional inspection,~~
9 ~~licensure or permitting by the state or municipality.~~

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
