PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to school safety; prohibiting false personation of a student; prescribing punishment upon conviction; prohibiting trespass on school premises after false personation; providing for penalties upon conviction; defining term; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 24-131.3 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Any person who falsely personates a student of a public school with the intent to trespass on school premises shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be punished by a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than ninety (90) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

1       B. Any person who trespasses on school premises by falsely  
2 personating a student shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon  
3 conviction, shall be punished by a fine of not more than Five  
4 Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or by imprisonment in the county jail for  
5 not more than ninety (90) days, or by both such fine and  
6 imprisonment.

7       C. As used in this section, "school premises" means the real  
8 property on which a public school is located including, but not  
9 limited to, school buildings, grounds, athletic fields, gymnasiums,  
10 auditoriums, and parking lots owned or leased for use by the school.

11       SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

12       SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
13 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
14 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
15 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
