PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to crimes and punishments; making  
certain acts unlawful; providing penalties; providing  
for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 650.12 of Title 21, unless there  
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any person who, without justifiable or excusable cause, commits  
during the commission of a crime, a battery or an assault and  
battery upon an employee of the retail establishment while such  
employee is in the performance of his or her duties shall, upon  
conviction, be guilty of a felony punishable by a term of  
imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for a  
term not exceeding two (2) years, or by a fine not exceeding Two

1 Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00), or by both such fine and  
2 imprisonment.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
