PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to appropriations; making appropriation to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce; providing for expenditure of funds for purposes of certain capital assets; stating essential government purpose of expenditures; providing for noncodification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025, the sum of Seventy-five Million Dollars (\$75,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to implement the provisions of this act to make capital improvements within the boundary of the Ardmore Airpark.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

1 The expenditures authorized by this act, if made in accordance
2 with the requirements of this act, shall be construed as an
3 expenditure of public funds in furtherance of state governmental
4 functions.

5 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

6 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
