17	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified												
18	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 9301 of Title 74, unless there												
19	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:												
20	A. There is hereby created a Telecommunications Division within												
21	the Oklahoma Department of Transportation.												
22	B. The Director of the Oklahoma Department of Transportation												
23	shall assign qualified personnel to staff and manage the												
24	Telecommunications Division.												

C. The Oklahoma Department of Transportation shall promulgate rules and regulations to implement the creation of the Division and to carry out the duties described in section 2 of this act.

4 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 9302 of Title 74, unless there 6 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Telecommunications Division shall initiate a feasibility
study to assess the creation of a statewide interoperable radio
network and facilitate access for state agencies, counties,
municipalities, tribal governments, and schools.

B. The Division shall issue a request for proposal to hire a consultant to conduct the feasibility study. The Request for Proposal shall outline the objectives, scope, and requirements of the study.

15 C. The feasibility study shall focus on evaluating the 16 technical and logistical aspects of enabling access to state-funded 17 radio towers and the creation of a statewide interoperable radio 18 network system to enhance public safety communications.

D. The Division shall develop and implement a timeline for thefeasibility study and subsequent actions.

E. By July 1, 2025, the Division shall provide a report on the
progress of the feasibility study and recommendations to the
Oklahoma Senate and the Oklahoma House of Representatives.
