NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 325.20 of Title 74, unless there 16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 17 Α. In lieu of an automatic fire extinguishing system, portable 18 fire extinguishers shall be installed in mobile food establishments 19 that produce smoke or grease-laden vapors. All fire extinguishers 20 shall be inspected annually by a licensed contractor. A Class K-21 rated, portable fire extinguisher is required for all cooking 22 equipment involving solid fuels or vegetable or animal oils and 23 fats. All portable fire extinguishers shall be in clear view and 24

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immediately available for use.

B. The provisions of this section shall cease to have the force and effect of law on November 1, 2025. SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval. 02/13/24 59-2-10146 ΤJ

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
